After reviewing the above-entitled cases and discussing the matter with you, the following plea offer, which we mutually composed, will be available until May 25, 2006:


1. The Defendant will waive preliminary hearing in Cr. No. SDTA-06-00217/LC-06-435 and the State will dismiss without prejudice the counts in all cases listed above provided that the following conditions are met:
  - A. The defendant waives all HRPP Rule 46 and statute of limitation rights;
  - B. The defendant withdraws all civil claims against the County of Kaua'i, and any and all of its various departments, and signs releases of liability;
  - C. The defendant takes down his website:  
[www.kpinkerton.com](http://www.kpinkerton.com) ;
  - D. The defendant discloses how he received the screen shot of the Kaua'i Police Department's RMS screen that is displayed on his website;
  - E. The defendant writes letters of apology to Officers Gilbert Asuncion, Steve Vinzant, and Phillip Banquel;

F. The defendant agrees to move away from Kaua'i within 60 days of May 25, 2006, and understands that charges will be reinstated if he moves back to Kaua'i;

2. This plea offer is null and void if Defendant files a motion to suppress or dismiss or fails to satisfy any of the abovementioned conditions by the dates indicated.
