Legislative Coordinators Ohana: I want to expression appreciation from the Governor's Office for the excellent job you are doing this legislative session. With the exception of a handful of bills, all of the Administration's Legislative priorities are getting hearings and moving through the Legislative process in both the House and Senate. We know this would not be possible without the hard work of you, your Directors, Deputies and staffs. Three updates:

- **Senate Committee Testimony:** The Senate had seen a high volume increase in e-mail testimony. to help ensure that Departmental testimony is received by the Committee members, the Senate Clerk's office has set up a new, separate e-mail account for testimony coming from the executive branch departments, judiciary, UH and OHA. Effective immediately, your testimony can be sent directly to *SenateTestimony@capitol.hawaii.gov*. Attached is a copy of a memo from the Senate providing further details on getting testimony to them.

- **Testimony to Communications Office:** The Policy Office has made arrangements for the Governor's Communications staff to obtain access to testimony submitted by all departments. Please continue to send your draft testimony to your policy analyst and your final testimony to *Gov.Policy@hawaii.gov* as you have been doing. We would also like to encourage you to work closely with your departmental Public Information Officers (PIOs) to alert them to testimony or bills that may receive media attention. There are many important measures moving through the House and Senate this session, and the PIOs are often the first point of contact for inquiries about these measures.

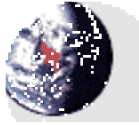

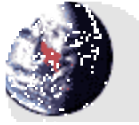

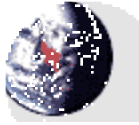
