A week from today, Hawaii's elections will be over for most candidates. We could use some more contributions here and here's why:

House District 24. The incumbent is Jim Shon. He is a main enemy of tobacco in the House. (See previous memo) Samson Aiona can beat this guy in the General. I have interviewed Sam and He would be a good vote for us. I recommend \$1,000.

House District 25. The incumbent is Ken Hiraki. The Republicans have found a great candidate in former Army Intelligence Officer, Richard Brawley. I recommend \$1,000.

Senate District 14. The incumbent is Milton Holt, our main guy in the State Senate. We did a poll here in July which showed Milton losing to anti-tobacco Representative Suzy Chun-Oakland by 54% to 24% with 22% undecided. Since then, Milton has turned things around and the race is a dead heat with Milton beginning to pull away. (He won his last race against a much weaker candidate--in 1992--by a vote of 8800 to 2200) His TV and massive house to house effort is paying off. Also he led the fight against gay marriage and Suzy was a big supporter of that. The District is heavily Japanese, Filipino, and mixed. Only 11% Caucasians in the District. Less than a third are college educated. The District is blue collar down to its rubber slippers. I am personally working this race at least four hours a day. Milton is \$50,000 short of his budget right now. That is, he needs a cash infusion of \$50,000 to pay his campaign bills. Phillip Morris is going to put in another \$2,000. I recommend that RJR also make another contribution to Milton of \$2,000.

Senate District 25. The incumbent is Whitney Anderson. I had asked for \$1,000 here, PM is giving \$2,000. Upon reflection, PM is going to give another \$2000 and I recommend that we do the same, bringing our combined total to \$7,000. Whitney is going to need about \$100,000 to defeat former Rep. Jackie Young.
